

As of right now, the only two ways to access Moodle are by going to a web browser and navigating to the web page or using an app with limited functionality. If you want to check a grade, you have to get on the page and log in. If you're checking a syllabus, or downloading notes, it's the same. As of right now, there is an app for Moodle available on iOS, however is does not download data from Moodle, it simply brings up a scaled browser window with Moodle inside of it. From the app, you can't look at grades or due dates.
